WEDDING CEREMONY CHECKLIST

Before the Wedding Day

- Order of Wedding Party's entrance defined
- Wedding Party knows how and when they will enter
- Wedding Party knows where they will stand or sit
- Individual who will be providing entrance cues delegated
- Ceremony cues discussed with Wedding Officiant
- Pre-processional music selected
- Parents processional music selected
- Groom's processional music selected
- Bridesmaid's processional music selected
- Bride's processional music selected
- Recessional music selected
- Music selected for special moments during the ceremony
- Cue points for special music selections adjusted or edited
- All Music "play listed" in both performance and backup computers
- Alternate location established (outdoor ceremonies)

On the Wedding Day

- Availability and accessibility of electricity ascertained
- Provisions made for shading equipment (outdoor ceremonies)
- Electrical outlet(s) tested
- Battery-operated P.A. systems charged (ceremony sites w/out electricity)
- Microphone cable(s) buried in sand (beach ceremonies)
- Microphone stands for soloists positioned
- New batteries placed in cordless handheld and lapel microphone transmitters
- DJ console and speakers set up
- All microphones tested and levels adjusted
- Soloists rehearsed as necessary
- Music sound-checked
- Backup system cued up
- Van moved to appropriate parking area and all extraneous gear positioned out of sight
- Entrance cues coordinated with delegated person
- Wedding Officiant and Groom wired with lapel microphones
- Pre-processional music playing as guests arrive
